

Vibe Parent Information Communication for 2025-2026 Season

The Vibe's Purpose

- What is The Vibe?
 - We are a volunteer organization that is a not-for-profit (we are a 501c3) that supports our competition dance team for FootNotes. We have a Board and Chairs that coordinate all activities for our dancers.
 - All the communications, coordination of the dancers, dancer support, and all social aspects
 of the competition team are done by The Vibe through volunteer efforts.
 - o Our dancers dance for FootNotes....we will always be called FootNotes at competitions.
- Our Dancer Stats this year: Total of 75 dancers on the team this year with 6 groups (Bravo 12, Elite 12, Nova 11, Ovation 12, Premier 13, Prodigy 15)
- Reminder about payments: Tuition and Vibe Payments are separate items, and both are paid to FootNotes (not The Vibe).
 - o "Tuition" is for your dancer's monthly dance class fees.
 - Vibe Payments are designed to cover the <u>expected</u> expenses of the competition dancer beyond the actual classes at FootNotes. This includes paying for choreographers, costumes, competition entry fees, dance conventions, and in-house master classes. These are expected/estimated expenses.
 - NOTE: You will receive an "Extras" payment plan if it is relevant for your group. Any 'extra' dances above and beyond what is listed in your Group payment plan are considered "extra".
 It is your responsibility to know when these dues are to be paid/will hit your CC on file...they are due in November and January.
- Showcase is our largest fundraiser for The Vibe and serves 3 purposes: 1) it is a fundraiser to support dancer activities, which includes costs incurred with putting on Showcase, social activities, faculty gifts, etc.; 2) it gives our dancers a chance to perform the dances in front of an audience prior to their first competition, and 3) it promotes The Vibe Performance Company dancers (raise awareness to attract new members for the future). For this fundraiser to be successful, each family is required to sell or purchase at least 10 tickets to the Showcase performances as per the Vibe Performance Company Handbook/Agreement signed by each family. Unsold ticket requirement will be invoiced following Showcase in February and outstanding balances will be billed to your FootNotes account in April.

- Review of Attendance Policy
 - o Being on time to class is critical to team performance.



- Exceeding more than 3 unexcused absences may result in removal from a performance/competitions.
- o Following winter break in January, ALL weekday/weekend practices are mandatory.

Classroom/Studio etiquette

- Be on time and respectful of teachers and students at all times. This includes no speaking over a teacher, no cell phones and no homework to be brought into class at any time.
- Students are expected to show up and observe classes when sitting out of active participation due to illness or injury.
- o HOWEVER, no student should come to class with a fever.
- Schedule Conflicts All conflicts will be taken into consideration...however, with the number of dancers we have, it is sometimes impossible to work around all conflicts. Extra-curricular activities will not be taken into consideration.
 - If you have additional schedule conflicts, you will have the ability to add them through the
 Schedule Conflicts Update form.

 - HIGH SCHOOL PARENTS: Reminder to please review your dancer's standardized testing schedule, Prom/Homecoming dates etc.
- **Dress Code** (at class, at workshops, onstage)
 - Dancers are expected to adhere to dress code at all times. Girls must wear fitted dance attire (crop tops, sports bras, leotard/dance shorts or leggings). No baggie t-shirts. Black leotards
 & pink tights must be worn for all ballet classes with hair secured in a neat bun.
- **Bring a Notebook to Class** Have your kids bring a notebook to class for notetaking/teacher comments, judge's feedback, etc.

Volunteer Needs

- Member volunteer requirements are mandatory: it is 12 hours per dancer family, 20 hours if two dancers.

- Showcase & Recital are "all hands on deck" Vibe sponsored events. Volunteer participation from ALL parents (including parents of Senior dancers) during these events is expected. More details and event specific volunteer sign up opportunities will be shared prior to the events.
- Additionally, <u>ALL</u> members are expected to volunteer for/at the Showcase event.
