COMPETITION HAIR AND MAKE-UP SUPPLY LIST

Below is information regarding the required make-up and hair tools that our girls will need for competitions. **Competition hairstyle & make-up is required for ALL female dancers.** All dancers need to wear make-up to highlight their features, so that the stage lights do not wash out their faces. Please find below the chosen hairstyle for this season as well as a list of make-up and colors.

COMPETITION HAIR:

Hair should be in slicked back, MID-low straightened pony with a center part. Top of the straightened pony should be aligned with the top of the ear. Each dancer will be checked by Cheryl at each competition.

COMPETITION MAKE-UP:

***New members:** Cheryl has pre-purchased competition eyeshadow/blush palettes for all new members and will apply the charge to each dancer's account (\$40). *Please make sure your daughter knows her competition make-up is not for playtime - what goes in the kit, stays in the kit. There is nothing worse than showing up for competition and finding a crucial piece missing!*

***Returning members:** We will be using the same eyeshadow/blush palette as last year **with the addition of a new lipstick that you will need to order.** Please take an honest assessment of your dancer's make-up from last year and make sure they have the eyeshadow and blush palette. If either of these are missing, Cheryl has a few available if needed as they are currently out of stock on the website.

***ALL members:** We will be using a **NEW lipstick** this year that everyone will need to order individually. **Maybelline Super Stay Vinyl Ink Longwear Liquid Lipcolor** in shade "Royal". [Click here for Maybelline link.](#) [Click here for Amazon link.](#)

What the parent is responsible for purchasing:

- Make-up storage case or hanging bag.** You will need some type of make-up case or hanging makeup organizer to store make-up and supplies. *After reviewing the list below, you will understand why a case/organizer is needed!*
- Liquid foundation.** The foundation should be one shade/slightly darker than skin tone.
- Face moisturizer.** **Have your dancer USE DAILY** throughout the season so that her skin is not dry and flaky...it makes applying liquid foundation a LOT easier.
- Face primer.** **Always use** before applying your liquid foundation.

- Eye primer.** This helps the eye shadow STAY PUT for a full day of competition.
- Lip moisturizer/balm.** **Have your dancer USE DAILY** throughout the season so that her lips are properly moisturized. It will make applying competition lipstick a LOT easier.
- Make-up brushes & sponges.** We highly recommend you have the following: foundation brush or sponge per preference, powder brush, blush brush, eyeshadow brush, angled liner brush. EcoTools has a great eye enhancing brush option linked here: [EcoTools Eye Duo Brush Set](#)
- Mascara.** (black)

- **Tinted Eyebrow Mascara.** The brow gel/tint should be similar shade to hair color to enhance color and shape of brows.
- **False eyelashes.** These are required. We use the ARDELL brand, #105 Black, and start with 4 pair, and ALWAYS having 2 pair on hand for each competition.
- **Eyelash glue/adhesive.** (if you buy the Ardell 105 starter kit, it comes with adhesive).
- **Cotton balls or Cotton pads.**
- **Q-tip like dual-tip multi-purpose make-up applicators.** (one end has a point – super helpful for applying eyelash adhesive)
- **Make-up remover wipes.** (Neutrogena brand are excellent!)
- **Comb.** (the rat tail type is good for making straight parts)
- **Brush.**
- **Teasing or bristle/smoothing brush** (some people use it to tame hair into competition hairstyle).
- **Hair ties.** (to match the color of dancer's hair)
- **Labels.** For all the pieces/parts of your dancer's costumes, accessories, tools, make-up, etc. Labeldaddy.com is a good option. **LABEL EVERYTHING!**
- **Hairspray.** (whatever brand works well to for your daughter's hair type...so that it 'stays put')
- **Hair Gel** (dependent on your dancer's hair whether needed – Aussie brand "Freeze" gel (purple bottle) is a favorite)
- **Bobby pins.** (to match the color of dancer's hair)
- **Body Adhesive (optional, based on needs of each costume).** Some dancers find it is helpful to have "Stick It" or "It Stays" roll on adhesive to keep costumes in place. (Medical supply store or Amazon.com)
- **Double Stick Fashion Tape (optional, based on needs of each costume).** (Hollywood Fashion Secrets brand – can be purchased at Ulta, Amazon.com, Joann's)
- **Nail polish remover pads.**

More Items to Pack (Nice to have on hand in a pinch)

• Flat iron for straightening hair	• Nail file	✓ Water
• Steamer – recommend keeping in duffel throughout season. Great option here: Amazon Steamer	• Nail clippers	✓ Neat, non-greasy foods
• Stitch gun – lots of different options on Amazon. Great option here: Stitch Gun	• Kleenex	✓ Pretzels, snack mix, granola bars, crackers
• Safety pins (variety of sizes)	• Clear Band-Aids	✓ Cheese sticks
• Small sewing kit (needle, thread, scissors)	• Tylenol/Advil	✓ Grapes, bananas, raisins

There are also some items to think about having as a group. Perhaps a group member could coordinate getting these things together for their group

• Static Guard for the lightweight costumes	• Super Glue
• A multi-outlet power strip (for all straightening irons and/or steamers)	• Garment racks - There needs to be at least two per group (depending on how many girls are using a Dream Duffel)
• Extension cord	• Hot Glue Gun (you never know)
• Blankets or sheets for the floors and as cover-ups	• Needle and thread to match costumes
